The University of Calgary Faculty of Veterinary Medicine (UCVM) is Canada's fifth accredited veterinary college and the first veterinary college located in the province of Alberta.

Fully funded by the Province of Alberta, UCVM is committed to meeting the animal and public health needs of the province through its educational, research and outreach programs. Established following the BSE crisis in Alberta and a number of other important animal health events, UCVM was established with the goals of graduating an increased number of veterinarians with the skills to meet and adapt to the changing demands of rural Alberta, the food animal industries, environmental and wildlife health (ecosystem health), comparative health and biomedical research, and public health.

UCVM is committed to strengthening the connections between human and animal medicine, a concept known as **One Health**. Collaborating with the University of Calgary's Faculty of Medicine, UCVM will contribute to the health and welfare of animals and humans.

A showpiece of the Faculty, the Clinical Skills Building on the Spy Hill Campus is the site of hands-on clinical and diagnostic learning in the DVM Program and clinical and applied research.
